After more than fifteen years of exiled absence Ketas returns to his Writing Workshop to claim his citizenship in the Republic of Letters. Because of his portrayal of the Bigoted Rider, a metaphor for those who are intolerant of others because of their race or religion or ethnic or national origin, or their system of beliefs, he becomes their target for intimidation, harassment, and other acts of terrorism. When all this fails to deter Ketas from his literary pursuits, the enemies of his poetry target him for assassination, hence the nonce word and neologism, poeticide. The...
